On 22nd March 2021

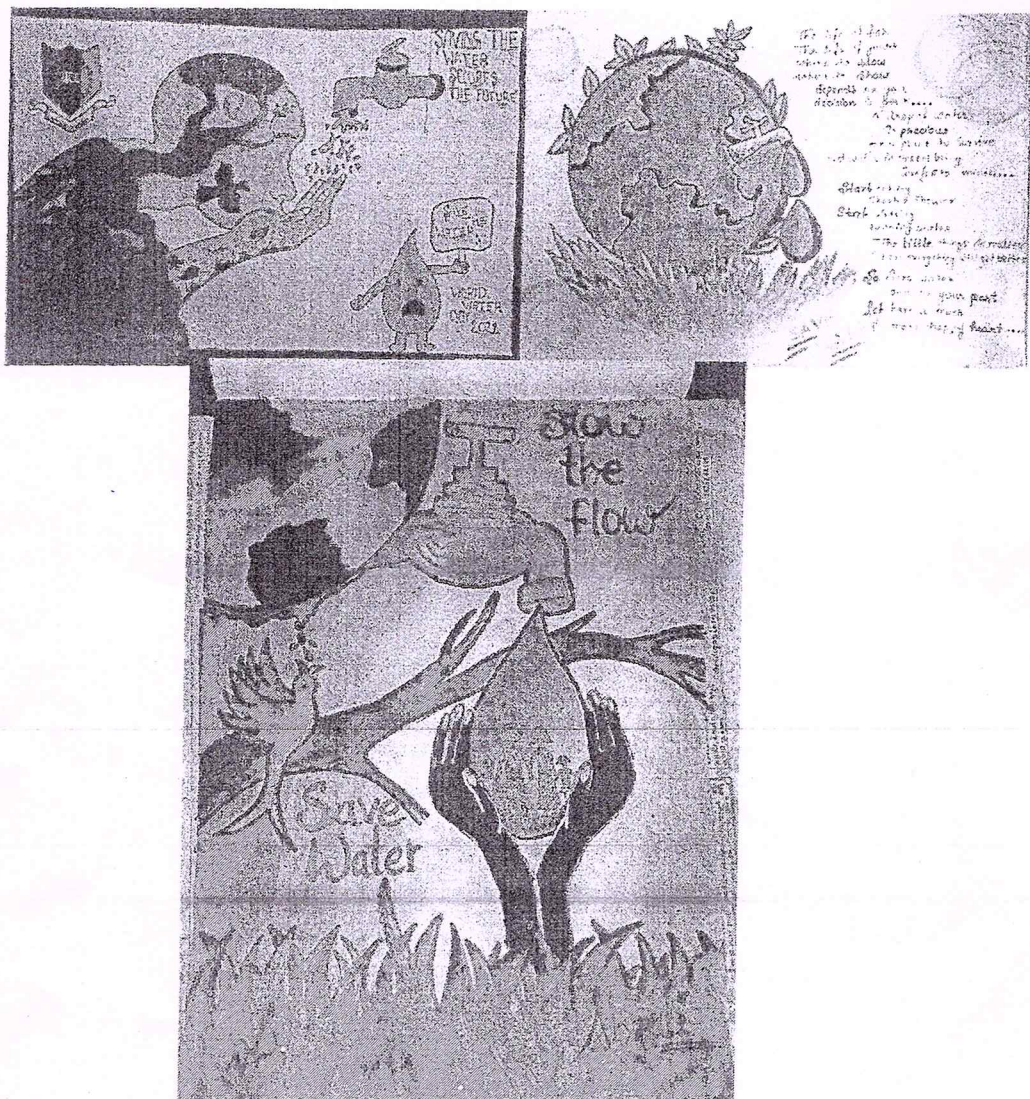

The core focus of the observance is to support the achievement of Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 6: water and sanitation for all by 2030. To generate awareness among students and staff members, Department of Geography in collaboration with NCC unit of College, celebrated World Water Day, on 22nd March 2021. The theme of World Water Day 2021 is "Valuing Water" which means what water means to people, its true value and how we can better protect this vital resource.
